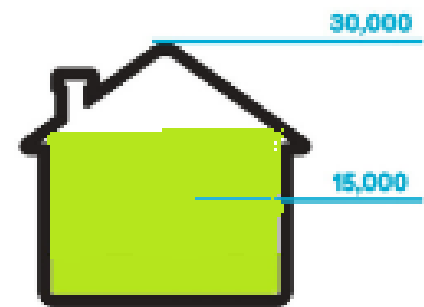


#### Fundraising news:
